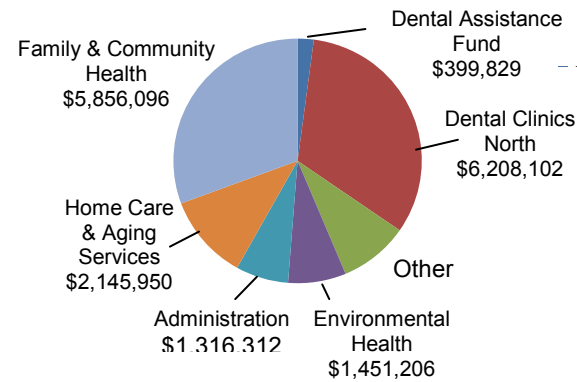

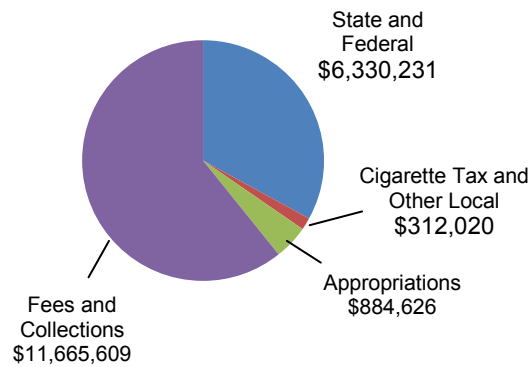

2010 Accomplishments

- ✓ Earning **full accreditation** from the Michigan Local Public Health Accreditation Program
- ✓ Finalizing major **H1N1 vaccination** program; overall, we administered or distributed nearly 30,000 doses of vaccine in response to the pandemic
- ✓ Responding to a pertussis (whooping cough) outbreak by increasing immunization rates
- ✓ Launching the **WISEWOMAN cardiovascular risk reduction program**, providing services to nearly 700 women during the first year of operation
- ✓ Opening the **Hornet Health Center** to increase access to primary care for youth age 5-21 in Pellston and providing services to nearly twice as many students as projected in Year I
- ✓ Licensing **Body Art Facilities** as required by Michigan law to decrease risk of bloodborne diseases such as hepatitis and HIV
- ✓ Offering tools for planning for end-of-life, including **Physician Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment (POLST) and Vial of Life**
- ✓ Contracting with **Antrim County Commission on Aging** for selected home care and hospice services
- ✓ Advocating for **restoration of the Medicaid Adult Dental Benefit**, restoring access to dental care for thousands of low-income residents.
